Dear Parents and Carers,

I am sure you will by now be aware that all schools are due to return from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. Wharton CE Primary School will re-open for all pupils on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021 and we can't wait to see everyone!

We continue to have the same systems in place in school and so children on their return will no doubt quickly adapt. The systems have been highly effective and continue to run smoothly.

As we return, I just want to remind you of the systems that we have in place.

From March 8<sup>th</sup> the **whole school will again need to adopt the one-way system** in the morning and at the end of the day, this includes when dropping children off for breakfast club. I appreciate that this for some is inconvenient but the safety of children and parents in the school grounds needs to come before convenience. In addition to the above we would like to remind you of the following:

- All adults to wear a face covering when visiting or entering the school premises including outdoor areas (unless you have a medical exemption)
- ONLY one adult to drop off and pick up
- Breakfast club is available on a Tuesday Wednesday and Thursday. Drop off is strictly between 8am and 8.10am
- Parents/carers to arrive and leave promptly when dropping off/collecting their child – **please do not congregate and maintain social distancing** as the virus is easily transmitted from person to person
- All staff to wear face coverings when they come out onto the playground during drop off and pick up times.
- Young people to avoid congregating outside school and mixing with other schools and go directly home.
- Lunchtime and break time routines for children remain the same as before Christmas
- Hot dinners and snack will be provided and the menu for the return on the 8<sup>th</sup> of March will be week 3

A quick reminder that drop off for all year groups is between **8.50 and 9.10am**. Attendance for all children is expected.

Collection at the end of the day is:

- 3.00pm for Reception, year 1 and year 2.
- 3.10pm for year 3 and year 4.
- 3.15pm for year 5 and year 6.

If you or your child is isolating and your child will not be returning to school on the 8<sup>th</sup> March, please inform school through the [closed@wharton.cheshire.sch.uk](mailto:closed@wharton.cheshire.sch.uk) account stating name, symptoms and the date they started, the date and result of the test and the end date of isolation.

We thank you for your continued support in keeping our children and each other safe.
