**Nasal Flu Vaccination:** You will have recently received a letter from the NHS Starting Well service regarding your child's Nasal Flu Vaccination which is now due. Nurses from the Cheshire and Wirral Partnership Trust will be in school on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October.



This vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against Flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Vaccinating child will also help protect more vulnerable friends and family by preventing the spread of flu.

**Please complete the consent form that you have recently received and return to school as soon as possible to ensure your child receives their vaccination.**
