What is a Parent Governor?

Parent governors are a core part of a school's Board of Governors. The role is voluntary and will appeal to parents who want to make a positive impact on their child's education and school life.

Parent Governors bring knowledge and experience and support the SLT (Senior Leadership Team) in strategic decision-making.



What would it involve?

Being a governor is a "hands-off" role decisions made by the governors influence the whole school but Governors are not involved in the day-today running of the school.

Governors set the vision of the school and oversee its performance.

You would be expected to attend ONE meeting each half-term and occasionally will be invited to other events.

If more parents want to become Governors than there are vacancies a ballot will be held. If this happens, ballot papers will be sent to all parents.

Governors are given all training that they need to be effective in their role.
