

Why TRAIN Proverbs 22:6?

All stakeholders collectively agreed that Proverbs 22:6 would be the biblical theological route for Wharton CE Primary School.

All stakeholders shared and discussed numerous biblical verses. Proverbs 22:6 captures the aspiration that all children flourish despite any social economic disadvantaged contexts they may find themselves in. This verse matched perfectly with our shared ethos for all children and staff to achieve their potential.

The verse was shared with the children and this evolved into TRAIN to help children understand why that verse is relevant in their daily life.

The context of Winsford has historically had a reputation where second and third generation families lack aspiration. Linked with the raising aspirations Winsford Education Partnership Initiative Proverbs 22:6 cemented a distinctly Christian vision rooted in the bible's teachings and values.

All elements of the curriculum are underpinned by this vision to prepare children for the complexities of life.

This vision extends to the wider school family with the work that we do supporting vulnerable families with issues such as debt management, housing, parenting, budget management for food and utilities including food parcels from the food bank and Salvation Army when required.

We are training all children to trust in God and reflect on the example of the life of Jesus. More recently the children's choices for House names of key biblical characters further enhances/develops their understanding of the importance of faith in God and the teachings that the lives of these characters' portray.

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
